

Taplow Cricket Club

Regulations

(To be read in conjunction with the Club Constitution)

1) Club Colours

- 1.1 The colours of the Club shall be maroon and gold.
- 1.2 The Club emblem shall be a Gold Cygnet-Royal Rising; and include the year 1850, the year of formation

2) AGM and EGM

- 2.1 Any motions for inclusion in the agendas must be submitted in writing to the Secretary at least 30 days prior to the scheduled date of the meeting (6.8)
- 2.2 Any motions must be signed by a Proposer and Seconder who must be voting members of the Club (6.2)
- 2.3 The Notice and Agenda of meetings will be posted in the Clubhouse.
- 2.4 At any meeting the Chairman has the right to declare that a vote on any issue shall be held in secret (6.7)
- 2.5 A voting member (6.2) may register a proxy vote with the Secretary at an AGM and EGM
- 2.6 Nominations for Committee Members and Team Captains shall only be made by voting members of the Club. A sheet for the addition of Nominations with names of Proposer and Seconder will be placed on the Club Notice board prior to the AGM. Nominees must signify their agreement to their nomination (Constitution 9.3.1/9.3.2/9.3.3.)

3) Financial Year

- 3.1 The Club shall prepare Accounts for the period ended 31 August in each year
- 3.2 The Accounts shall be examined by an Independent Examiner
- 3.3 The Accounts shall be presented to the AGM for approval

4) Subscriptions

- 4.1 The subscription rates for the different categories of membership shall be agreed annually by the General Committee.
- 4.2 Ages shall be as at 1 April.

- 4.3 The subscription year runs from 1 January to 31 December.
- 4.5 A late payment surcharge of 25% of the relevant subscription shall be levied after 31 May. (Not applicable to new members joining after that date)
- 4.6 Current membership shall be deemed to have lapsed if the relevant subscription for the year has not been paid by 30 June. The member concerned shall not be eligible to play or to use club facilities after that date
- 4.7 For new members joining later than six months into the current subscription year the relevant subscription rate will be at a negotiated reduced rate. All membership rights will apply from the date of payment of subscription
- 4.8 The General Committee is the sole arbiter of issues arising in respect of subscription rules and administration

5) Availability of Facilities

The Club may be used for a private function provided a Hire Form is fully completed and agreement is obtained from the General Committee

6) Liability

Neither the Club nor any member of its Committees shall be liable for the loss of or damage to any property arising from whatever cause in or about the Club premises, nor for any injury sustained by any person in or entering or leaving the Club premises

7) Guests

- 7.1 Any member introducing a guest shall be responsible for that guest's compliance with the Club Constitution and Regulations and shall not leave the Club premises before the guest.
- 7.2 No person whose membership has been terminated or temporarily suspended by the General Committee shall be introduced as a guest

8) Bar

- 8.1 The General Committee shall determine the bar opening hours and approve any proposed variation in these hours, within the prevailing licensing hours as prescribed by law (9.3.2.)
- 8.2 The Bar Committee can propose changes to bar prices at any time, which must be approved by the General Committee before being implemented (9.3.2.)

9) Matters not covered by the Constitution or Regulations

- 9.1 The General Committee shall have the power to deal with any question not covered by the Constitution or Regulations.
- 9.2 Any member wishing to object to a ruling of the General Committee shall forward a protest in writing, together with not less than ten signatures from other Club voting Members (6.2), to the Secretary who shall then call an EGM (8)

10) Club Constitution and Regulations


- 10.1 A copy of the Club Constitution and Club Regulations shall be posted in the Clubhouse
- 10.2 The Club Constitution and Regulations cannot be altered except at and AGM (7) or EGM (8) called for that purpose.

11) Priority

- 11.1 Interpretation of all Regulations must be consistent with the statutory requirements of the Amateur Sports Clubs (CASC's) as first provided for by the Finance Act 2002
- 11.2 Where there is any conflict between any of the Club Regulations and the statutory requirements for CASC's then the latter shall take priority


